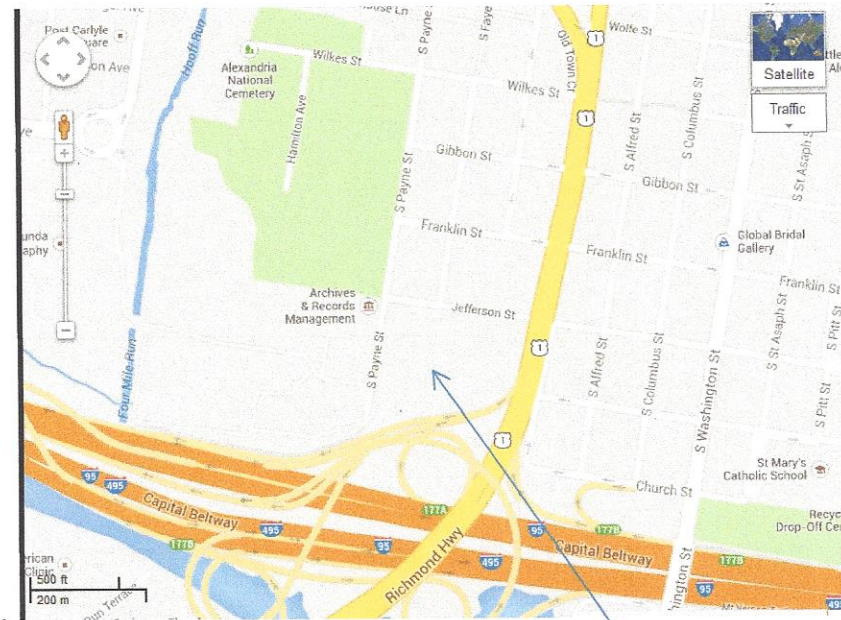


Amateur Radio Operations Plan for 2014 George Washington's Birthday Parade

First, Thank you for volunteering. Attached are some of the documents that will help.

Time line

9AM – Meet at the Fire Training Center parking lot to make assignments and move the Alexandria Radio Club Trailer.



Fire Training Center is at the end of S. Fayette St.

We need to depart the FTC and get to the START point before the police close the streets for the parade at 10AM

We will have THREE parking passes for parking at the Lyles Crouch School. So we will need to carpool from the FTC to the school. The Club Trailer will be at Parade HQ (see attached maps)

We will do our radio checks and if you want you can go to the American Legion Hall at Camron for coffee and donuts. At 10AM the Parade Marshals and volunteers will be briefed. If you want to attend that briefing remember that you need to be back at the Parade HQ (by the trailer) near Parade START by 11AM.

11AM meet with parade marshals that the Parade HQ and pair up amateur radio operators with marshals.

1200 Units FORM UP. We will need to assist the marshals in getting the divisions lined up and accounted for.

1230 All units should have arrived. We need to finalize the orders of March.

The Order of March is not dependent on the Divisions, but we will be working on EACH Division.

You will get a list of those who have signed up for the parade in DIVISION order with a number assigned to each unit.

You will need to provide CHANGES to the Comm TRAILER (in person if possible). There are only three items to write down.

1 – Unit Dropped (Unit 123 DROPPED) – means they are not in the parade

2 – Unit Added (National Order of Dragons is now UNIT 123A (will follow UNIT 123)

3 – Change in Unit (Unit 123 was GIRL SCOUT TROOP 2 and is now Girl Scout Troop 22)

PLEASE make your notes easy to read as you will present a TON of information at 12:45 and the guys in the trailer must integrate all this info and send it to the reviewing stand by Parade START which is 1 PM.

1 PM Parade Start. You may walk the parade with the marshal, but it's up to you to get back to your car pool. The parade usually ends about 2:30, but it will take about 30 minutes for the crowds to clear out.

3PM – 3:30 Depart for FTC and then to Me CASA on Duke Street in the Shopping Center across from 4600 Duke Street.

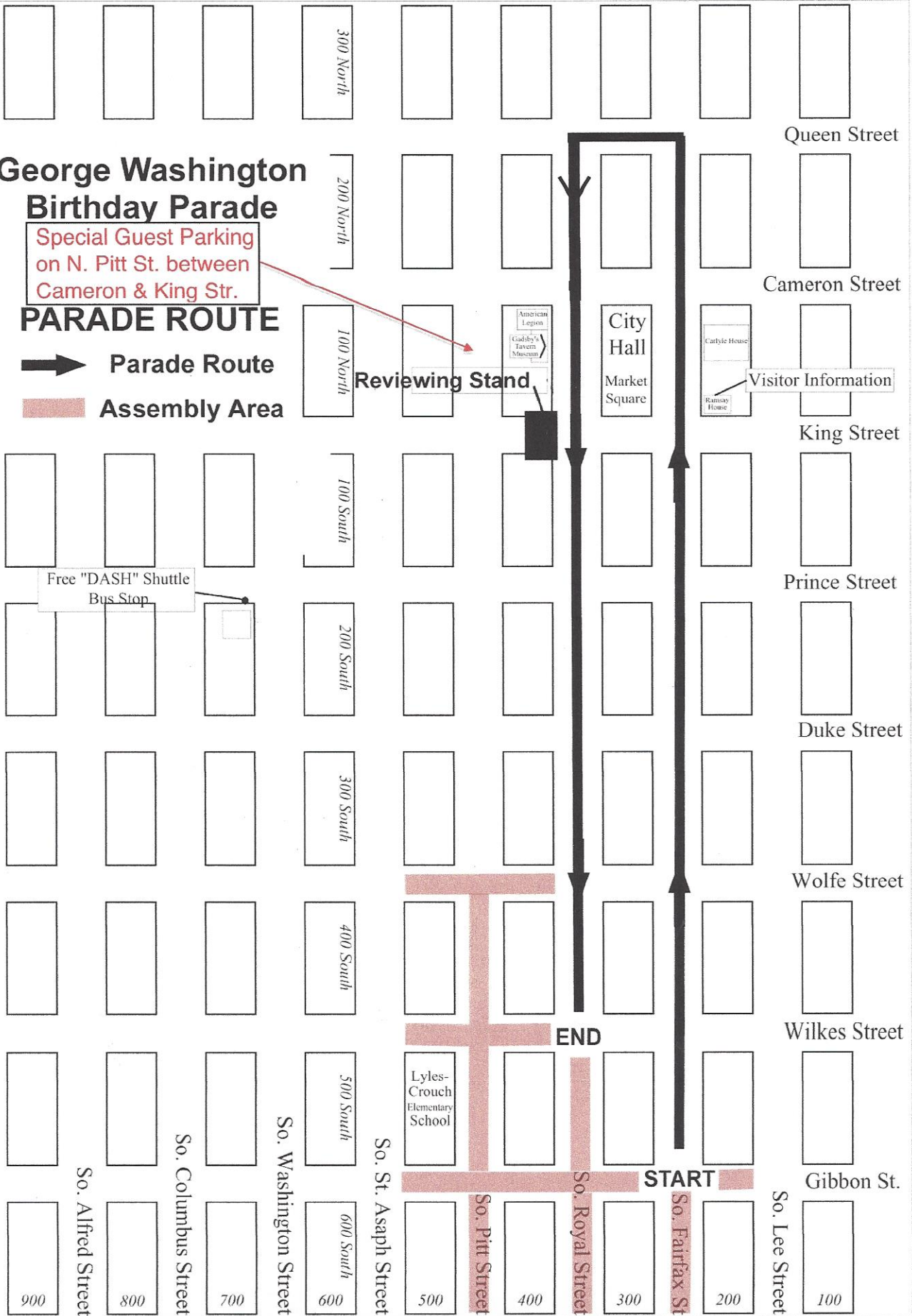
