Club Bylaws on November Elections

Article VIII. CLUB GOVERNANCE

Section 8.01 General

- (a) At the November meeting each year the Club membership shall elect four officers and three at-large directors from members: the officers shall be the President, the Vice President, the Secretary, and the Treasurer. These four officers and the elected directors shall constitute the Board of Directors.

Directors will serve staggered terms. One Director will serve a two-year term beginning after their election on odd numbered years and one Director will serve a two-year term beginning after their election on even numbered years. One Director will serve a three-year term beginning after their election.
