## Weather Radio

Next to having a smoke detector in one's home, a NOAA weather radio with SAME. is an essential item needed in todays home. It can be a Life Saver.


There are various models but the units with the Specific Area Messaging Encoding or SAME. What this feature allows one to program in their County, City, Parrish or Marine area into the weather radio so that warnings and alerts can be heard for that specific area.

The SAME code for CALVERT COUNTY is 024009. Only alerts for Calvert County will be heard for this county.

NOAA operates seven frequencies for weather radios. The one used for our area is transmitted from Manassas, Virginia on 162.550 MHz. Only the most imminent life and property threatening hazards are broadcasted with SAME. Operational guideline is that messages are alerted only in hazards urgent enough to warrant waking people up in the "middle of the night" or otherwise interrupting someone's activities at any time.






#### Vince Thrasher/KB3FS Awarded
