Ron Byzet / WA4PRR


As a long-time amateur radio operator, Ron Byzet earned his first license as a Technician in 1962 at the age of 12. To learn about his new hobby, he attended a ham class sponsored by the Mid-South Amateur Radio Association in Memphis, Tennessee, and became a member of the Delta Amateur Radio Club. Later in his amateur radio life, Ron was "grandfathered" to a General Class licensee when the code requirement was dropped to 5 words per minute. He passed his Extra Class license exam at the Richmond Hamfest in 2010.

Following his graduation from Memphis State University in 1972 with a degree in Electronics Engineering Technology, he worked for General Electric Medical Systems as an installation and repair technician for Patient Monitoring and X-Ray systems. For work purposes, Ron relocated to Washington, D.C., in 1978, and then again to Greenbelt, Maryland, in 1986 for the Bendix Field Engineering Corporation at the Goddard Space Flight Center. He was the Project Operation Control Center Engineer for the International Ultraviolet Explorer satellite and the Hubble Space Telescope until he retired in 2013.

Ron and his family moved to Calvert County in 1987 where he joined CARA the same year. Ron was active as the newsletter editor for CARA and SPARC until 2008. After spending a few years away from the club, Ron returned to CARA where he now serves as the Web master for CARA's website and as the club Secretary. Ron operates mostly VHF (6 meters, 2 meters, 432 MHz, 902 MHz, and 1296 MHz.). He also experiments with 10 GHz microwave radio.








