General Information:

Date: Saturday, April 16, 2016

Place: King's Landing Park, Huntingtown, MD

15 MPH speed limit at the park. Please do not exceed this.

Theme: The 2016 Western Shore Spring Cub-O-Ree theme is ***Cub Olympics!***

Time: 9 am-5:00 pm for all registered Cub Scouts and their leaders. (Arrive early by 7:15 am for registration; program begins at 9:00 am.) Webelos and their registered adults may camp overnight (Saturday night 16 April to Sunday morning 17 April) with a participating Boy Scout Troop. **Carpooling is strongly encouraged.**

Dress: Activity Uniform! A Pack related t-shirt uniform (Class B).

What to Bring: Lunch, Drink, Snacks, Water Bottle. Backpack, Rain Poncho (dress for the weather), Sunscreen, and their BSA medical form. Adults should bring a portable camp chair. Camping Webelos should coordinate with their sponsor troop to discuss camping fees and additional items to bring etc. *We also need a Release form for all attending because there will be pictures taken at the event (included in this packet).*

Medical Forms: The standard *BSA Annual Health and Medical Record*, parts A & B, must be completed for everyone attending. Adults and scouts. Packs should bring copies of these forms to the Cub-O-Ree. If your Pack utilizes a binder, you can submit that as well. Just make sure the Webelos that are camping have medicals to give to their Host Troop for the overnight. Medicals will be held by event leader until the end of the event. Registration Information:**

Registration as a Pack: Each pack must pre-register in advance as a group to participate at Cub-O-Ree.

Cub Scout to Adult ratio: Each pack MUST have no less than 5:1 Scout to Adult attendance. Tiger Cubs MUST have 1:1 Tiger Cub to Adult attendance. Packs should also provide volunteers for stations during the event, or for breakdown of the event.

Registration: NO registrations will be accepted after the **April 13, 2016 Roundtable**. Registration checks should be made payable to your pack. **The PACK registers as a group and makes a check out to NCAC-BSA.** Email registrations to Krissy Burke and bring fees and paperwork to Roundtable, by April 13th.
