DR-1X Repeater Internet Connectivity through a WiRES-X Node (Remote Connect Method)

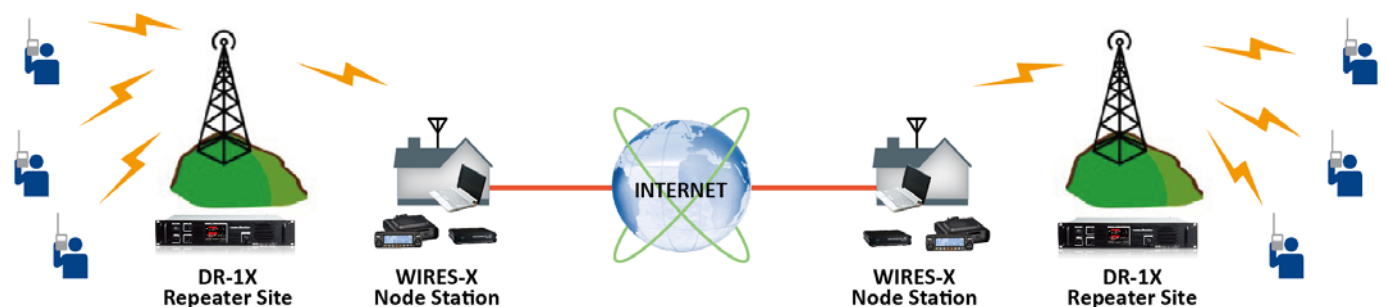
Dear DR-1X Operators;

Thank you for your patronage of YAESU.

Since the introduction of the System Fusion DR-1X Repeater, we have received some inquiries regarding the possibility of connecting this repeater to the Internet. After carefully considering these inquiries and related requests, we offer the following information to clarify DR-1X repeater connection and Internet linking capability using WiRES-X.

Connecting the DR-1X Repeater to the Internet can be easily accomplished using Yaesu mobile radios such as the FTM-400XD/D and FTM-100D and the HRI-200. That radio – plus a HRI-200 – are used to set up a WiRES-X node, and all that you need is a node set up within contact distance of the DR-1X repeater. That node is then used to interface the C4FM Digital or Analog signal remotely with the DR-1X repeater thereby providing the desired Internet link.

This configuration is possible with any of the firmware versions of the DR-1X repeater. If additional technical assistance is desired, please contact our Technical Support Department. We are certainly pleased to assist you with this System Fusion DR-1X repeater multi-site linking operation.
