### Overview



- This Afternoon Evening (Phase One)
  - Light snow accumulation expected to gradually move east across Maryland.
    - Some impact to P.M. rush hour
  - *Winter Weather Advisory* all day for Garrett/W Allegany with persistent mountain snow showers.
- Tonight Saturday (Phase Two, Heavier Snow)
  - Greatest threat to Eastern Shore, high uncertainty for western Bayshore
  - Snow, highest accumulations on the Eastern Shore
    - Blizzard Warning: Worcester County and coast (winds & heavy snow)
    - Winter Storm Warning: rest of Eastern Shore south of Cecil County
    - Winter Weather Advisory: Cecil, I-95 corridor (& Montgomery), south through lower southern MD. Also continues for Garrett/W Allegany
  - Wind
    - Expected 30-40 mph wind gusts.
      - Possibility for damaging wind gusts of 50 mph along the Eastern Shore.
    - *Gale Warning* for the Chesapeake Bay and Atlantic coastal waters.



### This afternoon - evening

## Light snow accumulations likely to gradually move east across much of MD with a cold front

- Garrett/Western Allegany: Snow showers all day, *Winter Weather Advisory*
- May be a few morning flurries/light snow showers northern MD
- Light snow likely develops over western MD early this afternoon & moves east:
  - Central MD, the metros, and lower southern MD
    - starting mid afternoon-early evening, likely with some impacts to rush hour
  - Eastern Shore
    - starting this evening



Greatest threat to Eastern Shore, uncertainty for western Bayshore

### **Tonight into Saturday**

Coastal low pressure


- Blizzard Warning for Worcester Co and coast
  Winter Storm Warning for rest of Eastern Shore south of Cecil
  - Heavy snow at times, combined with increasing winds, will make travel very dangerous.
  - Blowing and drifting of snow
- The rest of the western Bayshore counties & Cecil are in high uncertainty near the edge of the storm and should monitor closely.
- West of I-95/I-83 into western MD, lighter amounts.


Through the entire event

Greatest potential for highest accumulations is over southeast MD, but significant accumulation expected for all Eastern Shore.

Lower impact expected west of I-95/I-83.

Confidence is increasing, but since there will be a sharp gradient on the western edge of this storm, a wide range of possibilities exists for the western Bayshore counties and Cecil.






### Current Expected Snowfall

#### Through the entire event



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


### Reasonable Worst Case Scenario



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#### Strongest early Saturday morning through Saturday




### Frigid Wind Chill late Tonight - Sunday Morning

- Wind Chill Advisories at times, especially west




### Temperatures

Lows tonight & Saturday night



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


### Temperatures

#### Highs today & Saturday



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

#### Highs Saturday & Sunday




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#### Ocean City is the one site forecast into Minor Flooding



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
