SITUATION All tactical combat units require the ability to Move, Shoot and Communicate. HQ has determined that the Military Vehicle Collectors of California (MVCC) has the mobility and firepower covered, but lacks Tactical, Theater and Strategic Communications.

MISSION: Establish a Joint Camp Battalion Communications Center (BCC) at Forward Operating Base FOB Camp Plymouth. AKA The ComPost.

Dates: 17-19APR25

Operations: Deploy Recon teams, Coast (pool) Watchers; conduct area patrol missions.
