


# Impact Weather Briefing for: Tuesday, January 16, 2018



### **WATCHES/ADVISORIES:**

- Small Craft Advisory for all South Florida
  Waters this evening into tomorrow
- Wind Chill Advisory Glades, Hendry, Collier, Interior Palm Beach, Metro Palm Beach, Interior Broward Counties
- Freeze Watch Glades & Hendry Counties

**OVERVIEW:** A cold front will be moving through the region today bringing gusty winds and cold temperatures tonight into tomorrow morning. Wind chill temperatures will range from the mid-20s to lower 30s across Glades, Hendry, and Collier counties. In Palm Beach and Broward counties wind chills will range from the low to mid 30s to lower 40s as you approach the coast. Miami-Dade wind chills will be in the upper 30s to lower 40s.

Minimum temperatures in Glades and Hendry Counties may fall below freezing. Therefore, a Freeze Watch has been issued. Will also have to monitor northern Collier county for the possibility of freezing temperatures. If necessary a freeze warning may need to be issued later today.

Rip current risk may increase once again later this week into the weekend.


