War came again in December 1941 and with it, thru to 1945, a depletion of the SJRA ranks. Although the membership was small, the club continued to hold regular meetings.

After World War II, with members returning, activities picked up and in 1950 the club acquired the call, K2AA, as a memorial to William Ebersperger, a past president. "Harmonics", SJRA's official monthly publication, as we know it today, was started in 1950. Prior to the change in format, the club published a dittoed sheet called "SJRA News".
