1. This is a Rain or Shine event. Make sure you are prepared for any type of weather.
2. Each Scout needs to **bring a Pinewood Derby car** to participate in any of our hourly Derby races throughout the day. You bring it, we run it...
3. Bring a pumpkin for Punkin' Chunkin'. We MAY have some on hand, but we recommend bringing your own, so you won't miss out on the fun!
4. Blank t-shirts will be available for purchase for \$5 each, or **you can bring your own light colored blank t-shirt** if you'd like us to silk screen the ScoutFest logo for your own commemorative, limited edition souvenir.
5. Any Scout who wishes to climb and meets the age limit must provide a medical form with parts A and B completed. (See attached)
6. Parking - One car for every 7 scouts will receive a FREE Parking Permit.
7. If you are entering the Camp address in your GPS - 441 Rt. 9W, you will need to proceed approximately 1/2 mile past the destination to reach the Camp entrance.
8. NO CARS will be permitted to drive through camp. We are committed to the safety of every Scout and Scouter in camp for the weekend.
9. Saturday Arrivals - If you are dropping off Scouts, you may do so at the Main Entrance. If you are staying for the activities, you **MUST** park in the Crestron parking lot and take one of the shuttle buses into camp.
10. See the attached ScoutFest Program for a sneak peek at the weekend's activities, shows and presentations. Your campsite will be assigned to you upon registration.
11. Every Pack and Troop **MUST** provide a completed roster. (See attached)
12. There will be food available for purchase for Saturday lunch and dinner (same menu for both), but we recommend you bring your own food supply for weekend camp cooking.
13. Should you need assistance at any time, our ScoutFest staff can be easily identified by the bright orange ScoutFest hat
