The Corporation Name shall remain PETERBOROUGH AMATEUR RADIO CLUB.

Description of Changes to Purposes

The Purposes of the Corporation shall now read:

- A. To advance Amateur Radio as a hobby by providing to members of the Corporation, aspiring to participate in that hobby, training in basic radio theory, and the International Morse Code;
- B. To actively support Radio Amateurs of Canada, and other similar organizations;
- C. To actively support Government and local Community Authorities when such support is in the best interests of the Community and the Corporation.

Description of Changes to Special Provisions

The special provisions of the Corporation shall now read:

- A. Commercial purposes, if any, included in the articles are intended only to advance or support one or more of the non-profit purposes of the corporation. No part of a corporation's profits or of its property or accretions to the value of the property may be distributed, directly or indirectly, to a member, a director or an officer of the corporation except in furtherance of its activities or as otherwise permitted by this Act.

- B. The Corporation shall have the power to accept donations, gifts, legacies, and bequests that may be advantages to the Corporation;
- C. The Corporation shall have one class of members; and each member in good standing shall have one vote.
