Ray H. Lewellen, 92, of Morgantown, passed away Wednesday, November 11, 2015 in the Sundale Rest Home in Morgantown. Born in Point Marion, Pa. on Jan. 8, 1923, he was the son of the late Playford N. and Martha (Honsaker) Lewellen.

A 1940 graduate of Point Marion High School, he was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, serving in the South Pacific Theatre of Operations for three years. Ray retired from Occidental Petroleum in Niagara Falls, NY, where he worked as an Instrumentation Specialist for 33 years.
